If unemployed, you need to be a registered Minnesota job seeker and have a Minnesota WorkForce Center card (blue stripe with the state of MN on top, your name, username, ID and bar code at the bottom; ask for it if you don't have one). You *don't have to be assigned to the Bloomington WFC* to join the group, you can be from any Minnesota city, but your card will be scanned each time, for internal reporting purposes. If you work, no problem, you are still welcome to join, but you still need a card.
